Howard County Clarinet Camp provides a fun week of learning about the clarinet and a furthering of musical skills. It is intended for young people ages 11 to 17 who have played for at least 2 years and love music and the clarinet.

Campers play in small groups with others of similar experience and in a clarinet choir. All students receive individualized instruction as well as small group coaching.

On most days there will be workshops given by visiting performing artists. They will introduce a variety of playing styles including jazz improvisation.

Afternoons are spent putting new skills into play with fun activities such as scavenger and treasure hunts.

A Friday evening concert will showcase the week's work.
